

RULES AND REGULATIONS – DETROIT KENNEL CLUB, INC.

ARRANGEMENT OF EXHIBITS. Exhibitors must agree to arrange their booths so as not to obstruct the general view or hide exhibits of others.

INSTALLATION OF EXHIBITS. Arrangement of exhibits and removal of all boxes and crates must be completed by 8:00 a.m. the first day of show weekend.

CARE OF THE BUILDING. Nothing will be taped or otherwise fastened to the walls of the building. Acceptance of exhibit space makes it obligatory on the part of the exhibitor and his employees that he or they shall not deface, injure, or mar Cobo Hall. Any damage done shall be made good by them to the Detroit Kennel Club, Inc. (DKC) or Cobo Hall. The exhibitor is liable for property belonging to Cobo Hall.

INSURANCE. Exhibitors wishing to insure their goods must do so at their own expense. Neither the DKC nor Cobo Hall assumes any responsibility for the safety of the property of the exhibitor, its officers, agents, or employees for theft, damage by fire, accident or other causes.

RESTRICTIONS. The DKC reserves the right to restrict exhibits which, because of noise, or for any reasons, become objectionable, and also to prohibit an exhibit which, in their judgment, may detract from the general character of the show. This reservation includes persons, things, conduct, printed matter or anything of a character that might be objectionable to the exhibit as a whole. By way of illustration only and not limitation, exhibitors shall not directly or indirectly circulate or cause to be circulated, petitions for signature or engage in similar activities.

LIABILITY. Neither the DKC or Cobo Hall will be liable for the fulfillment of this contract as the delivery of space if non-delivery is due to any one of the following causes: by reason of the building being destroyed by fire, act of God, public enemy, strikes, the authority of the law, or any cause beyond their control. Vendor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the DKC and Cobo Hall for all liabilities, claims, costs and expenses relating to or arising out of Vendor's acts or omissions.

MATERIALS. All materials for display purposes must adhere to the regulations of the Detroit Fire Department. Vendors' use of dogs or other livestock for demonstration purposes is prohibited.

ELECTRICAL. Outlets must be contracted through MOTOR CITY ELECTRIC AT LEAST 10 WORKING DAYS BEFORE SET-UP.

These rules are enforced by the Bench Show Committee of the Detroit Kennel Club, Inc. They have been formulated for the best interest of the exhibitors as well as Cobo Hall and the Exhibitors are respectfully asked to co-operate in the observance of them.
